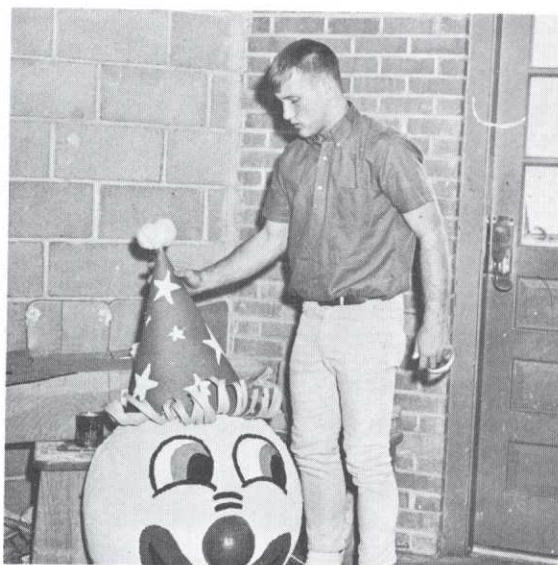
Art

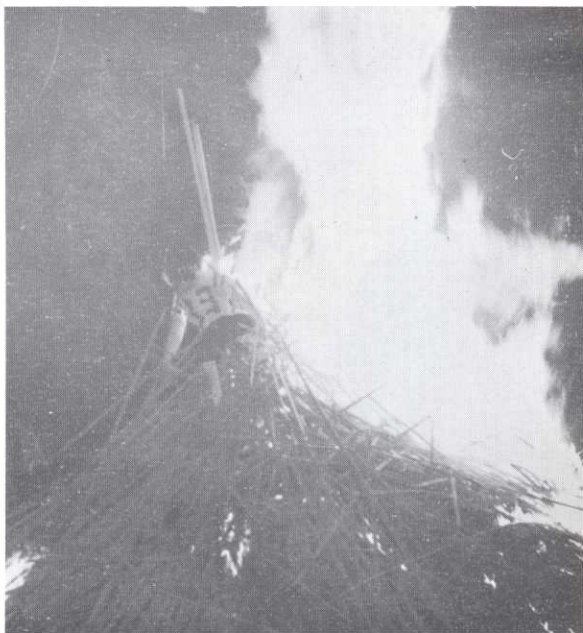

Gymnastics

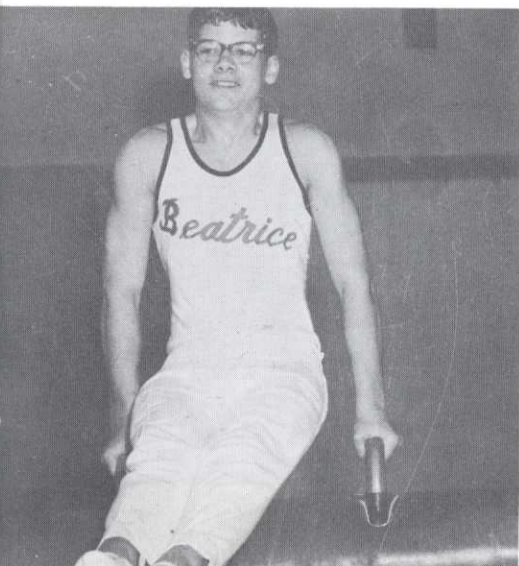
